

Age verification by a trusted third party




A person wishes to consult an online service for which access is subject to an age limit. Before granting access, the service provides a document to be signed by a third party who knows the age of the person with a certain level of confidence. This document doesn't contain information on the service that issued it.




The person select a third party among those proposed (bank, energy supplier...) through a new window.



The person authenticates on the selected third party and upload the document to be signed. If he matches the required age, the document is returned with the matching signature.



The person uploads the signed document to the service. The service verifies that the document matches the provided one and that the signature is valid. The service doesn't know the service used for signing this document, but he knows that the person has the required age for consulting its content.



The person is now granted to access the service!
