## 6 questions to ask yourself when using AI

### BEFORE USE

#### 1 Which AI should I choose?

- I compare different AI services and choose the one that best fits my needs because it limits the risk of my prompts being used for other use.
- I check the privacy policy to understand what data is collected, how it is used, and how I can control or limit its use.

#### 2 Do I need to create an account?

- If possible, I can use AI without creating an account.
- If I create one, I protect it with a strong password and two-factor authentication such as e-mail verification if possible.

#### 3 How can I protect my data?

- I check the settings to limit how my data may be used for AI training.
- If I can, I use temporary mode and turn off chat history.

### DURING USE

#### 4 What information should I share?

- I avoid sharing private or sensitive information because AI may misuse my data.
- For example, I hide my real name, address, school, passwords, bank details, or personal problems.

#### 5 Is the information reliable?

- AI can make mistakes and does not know what is true or false.
- I think critically and double-check important information.
- I verify information using reliable sources.

### AFTER USE

#### 6 What should I do after I finish?

- I review and delete my past chats if possible.
- If I no longer use the service, I delete my account.
- I always log out, especially on shared devices.
